LOCAL ECUMENICAL PARTNERSHIP: The Third LEP Gathering will be held in Augustine United Church, Edinburgh on Saturday 13th March, 2010. Local Ecumenical Partnership Gatherings are opportunities for people involved with, or interested in Local Ecumenical Partnerships to meet and share with one another. The third gathering will explore the theme "Getting to know you". The morning session will focus upon, 'Traditions in Conversation', recognising that on our journey together we learn much from others, both about their traditions and our own.
